The Most Commonly Donated Organs



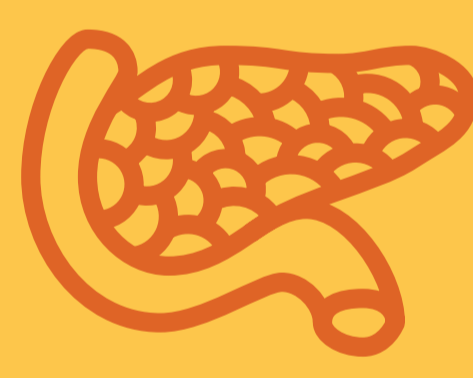
Heart

Pancreas



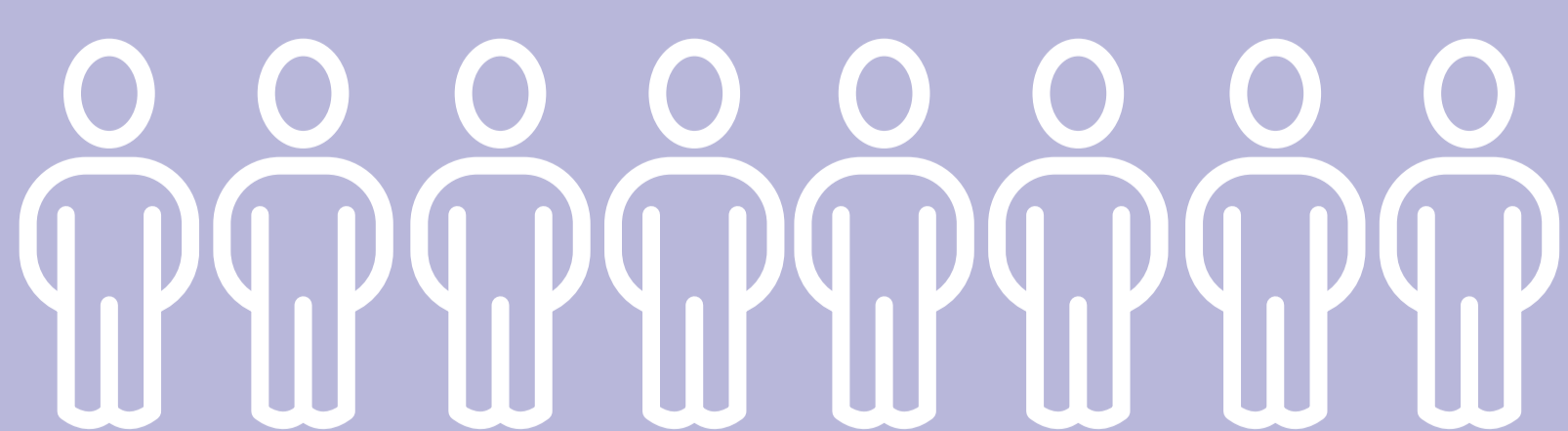
Kidneys

The Impact of Organ Donation
