- The application will be available online from February 1 to February 28 at midnight
- We recommend that you complete the Project & Budget Narrative prompts before you begin the application. You will not be able to save your work once you begin the application.

Include the following items with your online application.

- Project narrative: All responses have a 200-word limit unless otherwise indicated.
 - Organization mission (500-word limit)
 - o Specific purpose for the funds requested (250-word limit)
 - o Proposal goal
 - Key components
 - o Describe how your proposal will address the selected community need
 - o Explain how the requested funding will benefit the people you serve
 - o Estimate how many people will be served by the proposal
 - o Have you previously implemented the proposed programs(s)? If yes, share outcomes.
 - List proposal(s) measurable outcomes, how you will evaluate it and how you will track data.
 - o Share organization capacity and sustainability:
 - Does your organization have the capacity to implement the proposal?
 - How will you sustain the proposal in the future?
 - List any community partners you are working with on this program
- Budget narrative: Explain the total budget, including portions covered and not covered by this
 proposal. Explain other resources and demonstrate capacity and sustainability.
- Proposal budget
- **List of board members:** Include full names, board positions and business/community affiliation.
