What to expect during a virtual visit

We use a team-based approach that includes a geriatric medicine physician, nurse and social worker. Your appointments will be a video call on your tablet, smartphone or computer. They will include time for you and a caregiver to each meet with the team member. They will:

Review your medications, focusing on ones that are high risk for older adults.

Assess your fall risk.

Provide cognitive testing.

Review and order diagnostic imaging if needed

Evaluate you for any other health issues common in older adults.
